Material and Equipment Identification and Usage

Turface - Used as a soil conditioner to help maintain moisture in the skin.

Play Ball – New product we are trying. This is a water absorption material. USE SPARINGLY. No need to dump a bag in a space where there is standing water.

Mound mix - This is for the mound repair only. Loose material used to fill in area of the mound that need to be leveled.

Mound bricks – This is used for the mound repair only. Primarily used for large holes from pitchers. Fill with the brick first, then dress around bricks with mix.

Line marker - Used for creating batters boxes and foul lines on the skin surfaces only.

Paint – Used for foul lines on grass only.

Washington infield mix – This is used to fill low areas in the base paths and mix with existing skin material.

Divot mix – Used to fill in low area anywhere on the grass or tearouts and then to seed.

Tractors

John Deere 214 – Use this tractor for mowing outside the fence and general towing of trailer and transport. Before each use, check the engine oil for proper level.

Toro Sandpro 3000 – Used to groom the skin area of the field. Note there are a gasoline tank and an oil tank. When filling with gas, make sure you are putting it the correct tank.

John Deere D140 – Use this tractor to mow ONLY the field. Do not mow the outer area of the facility due to rocks in the grass.

John Deere L110 – Use this tractor for mowing all grounds and the field.

Smithco Super Star 4352 – Used to groom the skin area of the field. Note there are a gasoline tank and an oil tank. When filling with gas, make sure you are putting it the correct tank.
